A Different Way to Promote Health and Mental Wellbeing

Reduced mental wellbeing, loneliness and social isolation can be significant issues for some older people, especially if they have lost a partner, if they are a carer for their loved one, or if they have a disability.

Our Wellbeing Navigator and a team of volunteers held their August Holiday at Home event in Wellesbourne last week enabling many older people who weren't going on a summer holiday to have a summer holiday!

The three-day holiday ran from 10.00am - 3.00pm each day and had a jam packed seaside themed itinerary that included all the enjoyments you would expect to find on a traditional British holiday - including good food, meeting new friends, fun and laughter, trying new activities and enjoying time away.

Evaluation forms were completed at the end of the holiday. 100% of holiday makers said they had had a good time. Comments included: 'I enjoyed meeting and making new friends', 'it was a breath of fresh air', 'I enjoyed everything so much'
